Deception (Abv: 4.1%) Abbeydale Brewery

Light and refreshing NZ pale, showcasing the incredible Nelson Sauvignon hops famed for delicious citrus flavours with hints of gooseberry and white grape.

Heathen APA (Abv: 4.1%) Abbeydale Brewery - GF

1.00pm Oughtibridge Brass Band - classic, rousing tunes to kick us off

2.00pm Charlie & Grete - Manchester based duo from Royal Northern College of Music, performing their interpretation of modern pop classics

3.00pm Holly Thompson - local singer performing soulful jazz, pop & rock songs with her fellow Red Tape Central collaborator Lily on guitar

8.15pm Rich Brown - expect a lively mix of folk rock covers, traditional sea shanties and powerful original songs

9.00pm Jacks Rake - our headliners bring their individual take on traditional folk songs & tunes plus original compositions with one or two covers thrown in for good measure
